To All Members of the SISFU Community,

We continue to find ourselves amidst an unprecedented global health crisis. To limit the load on the health system, the national government has extended the Enhanced Community Quarantine of Luzon until April 30th, 2020. Our students have been overwhelmingly positive in their reactions to studying 100% online, but many are anxious to return to normal life (or as close as we might get for the time being). To ensure that students are able to successfully complete all classes, assignments, and final exams, and to minimize the risk to students, faculty, and staff, SISFU classes will be conducted online until the end of the academic year. Once office operations resume upon the conclusion of the Enhanced Community Quarantine, SISFU will be implementing the following in accordance with Department of Health guidelines:

1. Complete Sanitation of campus.
2. Strict Social Distancing in all spaces.
3. Temperature monitoring of every person entering the SISFU campus.
4. 70% Isopropyl Alcohol Disinfectant in all rooms.
5. Recommend the use of surgical/N95 masks for all persons.
